

Quarantinable Disease Risk Areas Sep, 9, 2018

When you visit (stay or pass through) "Quarantinable Disease Risk Areas" during monitoring period, you must submit 「Health Questionnaire」 to a quarantine officer as you entering. Otherwise, you may be charged up to KRW 10 million in fines under the Article 41 of the Quarantine Act.


